



Thank you for lending your time to MCLL as a Team Parent!

The responsibilities of team parent are to assist the manager and coaches with off the field activities, help with communications to parents and keep the team running smoothly. Our goal as team parents should be to keep the manager and coaches focused on the players and getting the team ready to play.

Communication- Please keep your families informed. You will need to forward correspondence from the League. To aid in communication, you can set up a team website. This site has to be a secure site. Please respect the privacy of your players and parents if they don't want to be included. Team parents must monitor posted comments and pictures on the team site.

Recruiting Volunteers- All volunteers in MCLL are required to obtain an ID badge. Applications are online and submission is via email. Please make sure that the parents in contact with your players have their ID badge at all times. Applications for badges can be found on the MCLL website under ID Badges-Badge Requests. There are several positions open on the board, please talk with your team about being involved with the league. They can email Laurie at teamparents@millcreeklittleleague.com

Help Wanted- Teams need a lot of parent support to run smoothly. Please assist your manager in getting the extra help needed including field preparation/maintenance, scorekeeping, umpires, announcers and scoreboard operators at Freedom Field, Safety Parents, Snack Shack workers and Little League Day volunteers.

Uniforms/Gear/Equipment- Please assist in making sure that you have all the team gear necessary and in good shape for players to use. Please help your manager coordinate pick up and collection of equipment/uniforms if necessary.

Team Events- Coordinate with your manager and coaches any team events. It is always good to get the team together before practices so the players can meet and the manager can set the tone of the season. End of Season parties are a great way to finish the season and celebrate the players. You can collect funds and coordinate manager/coaches gifts and trophies for the players. Mid-season events are great for team building and a good way for the players to get to know each other better.

Optional duties- There are a lot of fun things that you can add to your team. It is up to you what you want to include. You can make a team roster/game schedule card for the parents. You can organize

post-game snacks. You can coordinate fan gear orders. Have fun but remember that you can also delegate tasks to other parents for additional help.

Team Banners- We have seen so many creative team banners over the years during the parade of teams. Please coordinate your team's banner. You can have it professionally made and collect funds from your families or have the players make one. Team banners can also be used to show pride at your games. ***This year the league will be providing banners for Majors and Minors teams to use for the season. The teams will return the banners with the rest of their gear at the end of their season to be used for next year's teams.***

Snack Shack at Freedom Field

The Snack Shack is our one and only fundraiser for MCLL. Each team is responsible for working shifts at the Snack Shack. Please work with your families to ensure that your shifts are filled and everyone shows up. Scheduling will be done on Sign Up Genius. Each shift is required to have a person with a Food Handler Card. This card must be on file with MCLL. There are 2 ways to get a card: either attend a Food Handler Class or get it online at <http://www.tpchd.org/food/food-worker-card/online-food-worker-card/> for the cost of \$10 which is not reimbursable. Cards received online need to be emailed to concessions@millcreeklittleleague.com so they can be added to the log. Please make sure that your parents follow through and send the cards in.

For those who are unable to work their assigned shifts, a substitute worker list is available. Subs are to be paid \$10 per hour by the family which hires them. Subs are to be paid before the shift begins-funds can be dropped off at the Snack Shack. When signing up on Sign Up Genius, please list the name of the sub under comments. Each shift must have one adult present. Subs are required to have a valid Food Handler Card and a valid 2017 volunteer badge.

Mariner Little League Days-

There are a limited number of tickets for each game and seats are first-come, first-serve so **please order early!** If you are going as a group of families or for a team event and want to sit together, please place a group order on one order form.

1. Review the order deadlines on the Mariner's flyer on the MCLL website to find out when you should place your order.
2. Complete the Mariners Little League Ticket Form. Make sure to include your full name, phone and e-mail address.
3. Attach check or money order for the total amount of tickets (**no cash please**).
4. Put the order form/payment into a sealed envelope and bring to the Snack Shack at Freedom Field before the ordering deadline. (Orders need to be placed in the Team Parent Box that is located under the front counter, do not post them to the board)
5. Pick up tickets at the snack shack at freedom field on or after the pick up date for your order. Please note the snack shack schedule to see what hours it will be open.
6. Enjoy the game!
